Climate Action is integral to ITV’s Social Purpose strategy of shaping culture for good. We want to make shows with the biggest impact on audiences and the smallest impact on the planet. ITV’s Climate Action targets were set in 2020, alongside a robust governance structure to deliver them.

Climate Action is a very fast evolving area. We regularly review our approach to keep up with growing regulatory requirements and stakeholder expectations.

ITV's Climate Action Targets

ENERGY

- Net-Zero: Reduce carbon emissions we control (Scope 1 & 2) by 48.2%, and emissions we influence (Scope 3) by 28% by 2030, and reduce all emissions by 90% by 2050, against our baseline year of 2019. These targets have been validated by the Science-Based Targets initiative. To support our Scope 1 & 2, target, we will power the business with 100% renewable energy by 2025.

WASTE

- By 2030, over 90% of our waste will be reused or recycled, with the interim 2025 goals of reaching 75% of our waste being reused and recycled

SOURCING

- 100% of our highest environmental risk suppliers will meet ITV's sustainability criteria by 2025, and we will support smaller suppliers to improve environmental impact by 2030

CULTURE

- All ITV colleagues to complete climate action training every year
- 100% of the shows we produce and commission in the UK to receive albert certification

ON-SCREEN

- Deliver on our Climate Content Pledge
